Sometimes children are identified as needing extra support or advice for various reasons. This may become apparent from our observations, conversations with parent/carers or our 2-year progress checks.

We can refer children for 'Let's talk more' screening.

At 3 years old, we may refer children for support from Nursery plus.

We can refer children to Speech and Language therapy service.

We can refer you to the children's centre for support.

We can refer children for 'Lets talk more' screening.

We can ask your local Health Visitor to support you.

We can ask our Early Years Advisor to come and observe your child to give us advice to support your child's needs.
