



We are now recycling crisp packets and pens as well as our usual recycling. These will be given to the primary schools recycling centre.












Rice pudding and fruit platter




Tomato pasta bake with sweetcorn and peas

# Children's recipe

- 1) Heat the olive oil over a medium heat in a soup pot. Once hot, add the onions, stirring occasionally for 10 minutes. Add the garlic and cook for one more minute.
- 2) Blend whole tomatoes and the juices in the blender, adding in the onion and garlic. Blend till smooth.
- 3) Pour the pureed tomatoes into the soup pot and turn the heat to medium.
- 4) Stir in the cream and cook for 10 minutes. Add salt and pepper (optional)
- 5) Ladle the soup into bowls.
- 6) For extra flavor, stir in cubes of cheddar cheese and top with chopped basil!



#### **Ingredients**

- 1 cup chopped onion
- 3 cloves garlic, crushed
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 28-ounce can whole tomatoes
  - 1/2 to 3/4 cup cream
- Small bunch fresh basil, chopped
  - Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 cup Cheddar cheese cubes, optional
